We are pleased to announce that the Scholarship Committee of our Society will be offering \$1,000.00 Education Grants. To be eligible, the student must be an insured member of the Foresters for the past year and be entering college in the upcoming fall. Application for the award must be completed in its entirety and submitted with all of the required items. Incomplete and/or late entries will be disqualified. The educational grant award will be paid directly to the recipient.

The Society also has access to endowed scholarships at the College of the Holy Cross, Emmanuel College, College of Our Lady of the Elms and St. John's Seminary. These are **not** full scholarships. They are based on interest accrued on our endowment to the college. We have no control over the amount of money provided you, as the sum of the endowment was raised and donated in years past. If eligible, the college will include the sum on the financial aid report to the student and family. Notify Headquarters of your interest and which school; then, we will notify the College that you are eligible for consideration based on your membership in the Catholic Association of Foresters.
